## VNA Northwest Receives Holiday Grant from The Community Foundation of Northwest CT

BANTAM – VNA Northwest is one of 45 local nonprofits chosen to receive a year-end critical needs/holiday grant from The Community Foundation of Northwest Connecticut. The Foundation grant in the amount of \$500 is made possible by the Marion Williams and Alice Edwards Fund, and the Draper Foundation Fund.

VNA Northwest will use these funds for its annual Holiday Giving Program, which serves individuals and families in the Foundation's 20-town catchment area. Parishioners from two local churches, as well as individual volunteers and VNA Northwest staff members, work together to provide and distribute gifts and gift cards to patients in need. Last year, the agency's Holiday Giving Program served approximately 100 individuals with limited financial means.

A home care, hospice and private duty agency that was founded in 1928 in Cornwall, VNA Northwest now serves all towns in Litchfield County. The agency has received additional funding for its Holiday Giving Program from the Berkshire Taconic Community Foundation and the Archdiocese of Hartford's Archbishop's Annual Appeal.
